The Institute of Tourism and Hotel Management (ITH) is the international arm of Tourism Schools Salzburg. The Institute was opened in 1965 and has so far educated over 2,510 international students, preparing them for exciting careers in the international hospitality and tourism industry.

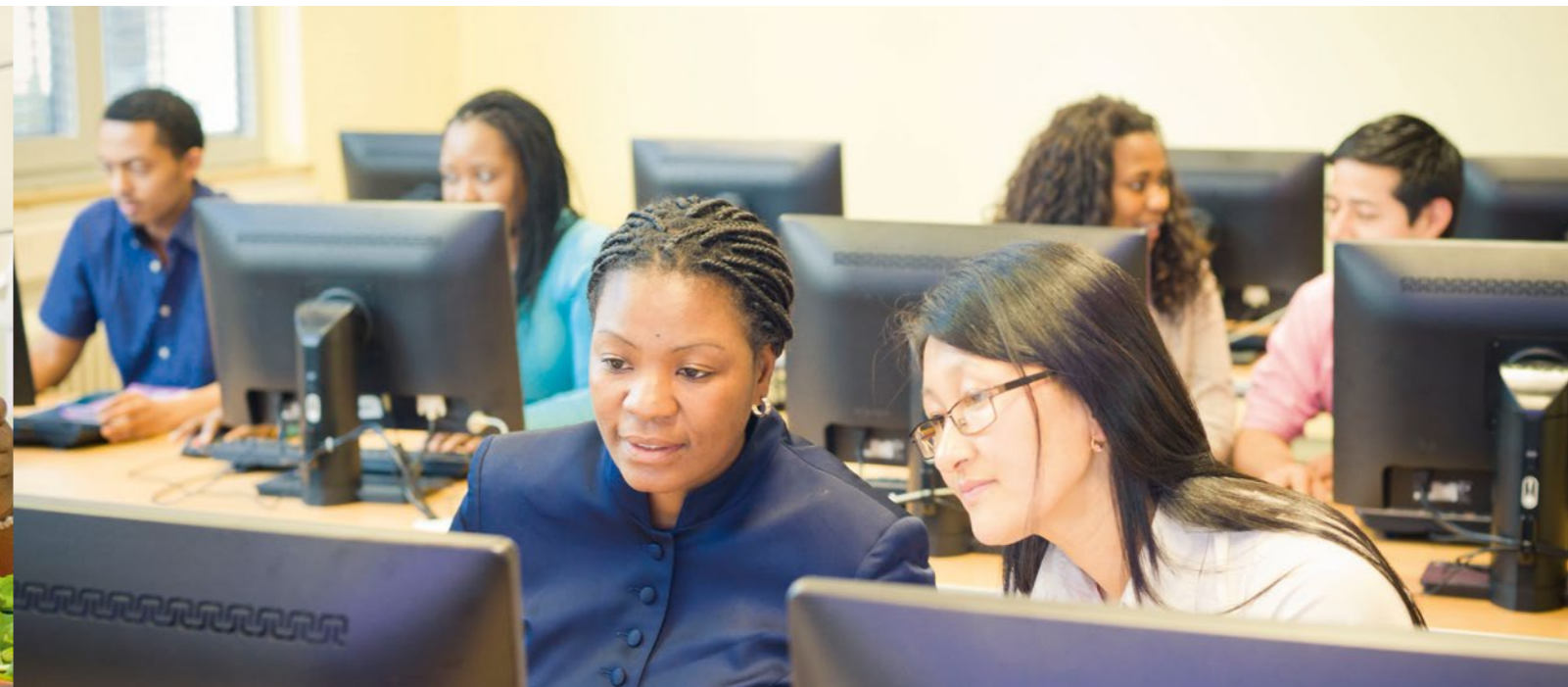

The ITH diploma programme is ideally suited for you if you already have gained experience in the hospitality or tourism industry and now wish to take your career to the next level. The eight-month programme is very intensive and requires you to demonstrate a high level of professionalism, self organisation and social competence.

Two different specialisation modules - Hospitality Management or Tourism Management - will prepare you for the career of your choice.

GENERAL MODULE

The teaching at ITH is delivered through a number of modules. All students complete the General Module, providing an overview of the fundamental principles of Management, Business Administration, Entrepreneurship and the use of modern software applications.

In addition to the General Module all students must choose a second module in either Hospitality Management or Tourism Management.

SPECIALIST MODULES

HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT

Training and education in Hospitality Management is provided in modern facilities with kitchen, bar and restaurant opportunities. The practical experience is coupled with teaching of the latest operational theories and trends in the hospitality industry. You will study subjects ranging from Food & Beverage Management to Front Office Management and Hotel Marketing.

TOURISM MANAGEMENT

This module will provide you with the latest knowledge for a career in the tourism industry in general, and in Travel Management in particular. Besides the focus on Destination and Tourism Management, you will acquire

practical knowledge and skills for managing tour operator and travel agency businesses. You will receive training in making online bookings, including making real-time bookings using systems that are widely used in the industry.

EXTRA MODULE

TEACHER TRAINING

Alongside the professional curriculum, you can choose to study a further Teacher Training Module. This is particularly suitable if you have a background in education or if you are likely to take on a role in training and supervising other members of staff. The latest trends in teaching and delivering training are explored, including the use of eLearning and problem-based learning. You will learn about didactic teaching methodology, as well as other teaching methodologies in common use.

During the course you will gain practical experience both at ITH and through giving lectures at Tourism Schools Salzburg. There are also opportunities for practical experience at a variety of other schools in and around Salzburg. During these teaching practice sessions you will be guided and coached by ITH teachers and external education professionals.

APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

To apply for this programme at ITH you must meet the following criteria:

- Be between 18 – 35 years of age
- Have a GCE-A' Level or equivalent, which enables enrollment at a university
- Have a minimum of one year's experience within the tourism and hospitality industry
- Non-native English speakers must have an English qualification e.g. TOEFL, Cambridge 1st Certificate, IELTS or equivalent

Successful candidates should be ambitious and open-minded with good organisational and time management skills.

A ONCE IN A LIFETIME EXPERIENCE

Teaching at ITH is carried out by an international network of industry experts, including guest lectures from those currently working in the industry.

ITH has an international reputation and its qualifications are recognised around the world. You will gain a unique experience while living and studying in Austria for eight months. Students from around the world meet at ITH to share ideas and experiences.
